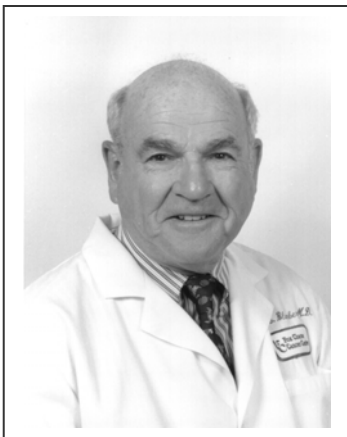

Baruch S. Blumberg, MD, PhD

Dr. Blumberg was awarded the Nobel Prize (1976) for "discoveries concerning new mechanisms for the origin and dissemination of infectious disease" and specifically, for the discovery of the Hepatitis B Virus. Subsequently he developed the first vaccine for Hepatitis B that saved millions of lives. In 1993, he was elected to the National Inventors Hall of Fame.
